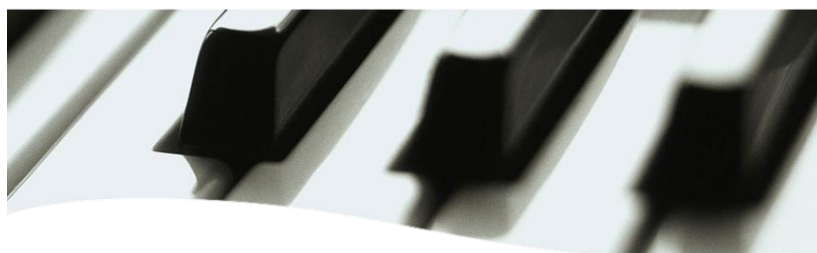

Through his well-known radio documentaries, the ‘Solitude Trilogy’, celebrated Canadian pianist Glenn Gould is widely recognized for his fascination with the north. Gould believed that music could create a “feeling of ecstasy that can elevate and distance the listener from the mundane reality of everyday life”. In the north, Gould experienced a sense of transcendence which found its way into his inspiring performances and recordings. Similar to other Canadian artists, such as Group of Seven artist Lawren Harris, Gould is classified as being part of a lineage of Canadian artists who reflected the north in their artistry. The *Glenn Gould Idea of North Tour* will take you to some of the most beautiful and treasured areas of Northern Ontario; areas that Glenn Gould used to visit on a yearly basis in search of solitude and clarity of mind.

The tour is led by Dale Innes, author of *Seeking Solitude: Glenn Gould and the Goldberg Variations* (Innes, 2015) and Johanna Rowe, a local resident and Wawa historian. Noted author and journalist, Peter Goddard, author of the newly released *The Great Gould* by Dundurn Press, will share his interest and knowledge of Glenn Gould one evening on the shore of Lake Superior that Gould frequented.

The coach tour begins and ends in Sault Ste. Marie, Ontario, one of Canada’s oldest settlements. It is located at the hub of three of the Great Lakes: Superior, Huron, and Michigan, and is surrounded by some of the most pristine wilderness in the world. It takes you along the stunning east coast of Lake Superior, stopping at spectacular sites along the way, such as Agawa Bay and Old Woman Bay, to Wawa where Gould spent his time. It also includes guided tours to nearby Magpie High Falls and Sandy Beach, two areas that Gould used to frequent regularly. Visitors will be accommodated at the Wawa Motor Inn, the motel that Gould used to stay at regularly in the 1960s and 70s. Come and share in this very special event celebrating the music, mind and spirit of Glenn Gould!

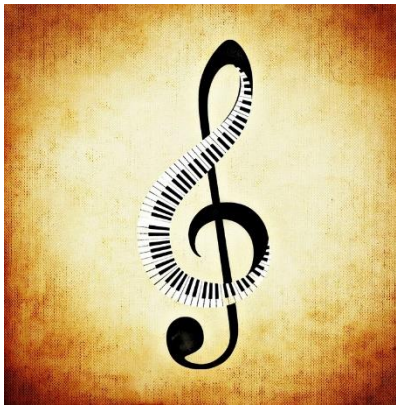

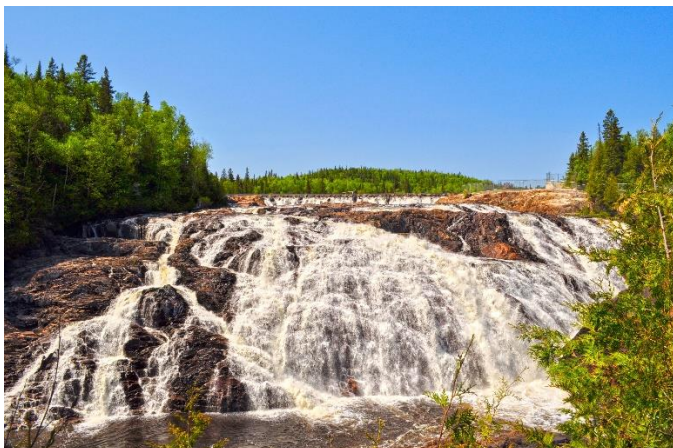
